EU directive 2023/1115, the Regulation on Deforestation-free products (EUDR) was adopted on 29 June 2023. The main driver of deforestation is the expansion of agricultural land that is linked to the production of commodities like cattle, wood, cocoa, soy, palm oil, coffee, rubber, and some of their derived products, such as leather, chocolate, tires, or furniture. Under the Regulation, any operator or trader who places these commodities on the EU market, or exports from it, must be able to prove that the products do not originate from recently deforested land or have contributed to forest degradation.

Products that qualify as a relevant product under regulation EU 2023/1115 are not used in the raw materials or during production of Sigma Stretch Film products. Based on our understanding of EU 2023/1115, the regulation is not applicable to products produced or supplied by Sigma Stretch Film.
